In fact, according to a report by Institute for Policy Research Studies (PRS), New Delhi, the percentage of students enrolled in class 10th is 77% while the percentage of students enrolled in class 11 is limited to 52%. This clearly depicts the drop-out of students from class 10th to 11th and makes the need for scholarships in India critical and compelling for them. Selection criteria.

- * Must be the citizen of India.
- * All applications must satisfy the basic participation requirements.
- * Applicant must be officially accepted by institute.
- * Normally , applicant should have a minimum 60% in class 10th and 55% in class 12th .
- * Colleges should be affiliated.

Note:-

Only 20% seats will be allotted under this scholarship in each college
Scholarship amount will be 1 lakh to 1.5 lakhs.

- * 1st year -20,000/-
- * 2nd year-30,000/-
- * 3rd year 40,000/-
- * 4th year 50,000/-
- * Rest of the amount of 10,000/- at the time of placement.
